Brown-eyed susan	<i>Rudbeckia triloba</i>	3-5'	yellow	sun to part shade
Butterflyweed	<i>Asclepias tuberosa</i>	1-2'	orange	sun to part shade
Culver's-root	<i>Veronicastrum virginicum</i>	4-5'	white	sun to part shade
Eastern prickly-pear cactus	<i>Opuntia humifusa</i>	6"-1'	yellow	sun
False sunflower	<i>Heliopsis helianthoides</i>	3-4'	yellow	sun to part shade
Flowering spurge	<i>Euphorbia corollata</i>	1-3'	white	sun
Larkspur, tall	<i>Delphinium exaltatum</i>	3-6'	blue, purple	part shade to shade
Obedient plant	<i>Physostegia virginiana</i>	3-5'	pink, purple	sun to shade

Orange coneflower	<i>Rudbeckia fulgida</i>	2-3'	yellow	sun
Purple coneflower	<i>Echinacea purpurea</i>	2-3'	pink, purple	sun to part shade
Sundrops	<i>Oenothera fruticosa</i>	1-2'	yellow	sun
Threadleaf coreopsis	<i>Coreopsis verticillata</i>	1-3'	yellow	dry
Three-toothed cinquefoil	<i>Potentilla tridentata</i>	3-6"	white	sun
Tickseed, tall	<i>Coreopsis tripteris</i>	3-6'	yellow	sun to part shade
Wild bergamot	<i>Monarda fistulosa</i>	3-4'	pink, purple	sun to part shade
